HWANGE NATIONAL PARK
LOCATION

Situated on the eastern boundary of the famous Hwange National Park in a 5 square km area.

ACCESS**By Road**

- Most guests fly into Victoria Falls Airport and then take the two-hour road transfer to Hwange Main Camp where guests are met by a Hide representative. The Hide is a little over an hours drive from Hwange Main Camp through the National Park. This transfer is conducted in a Hide open safari vehicle and offers game viewing opportunities.

Self-Drive

- Guests can opt to self-drive into Camp in their own 4WD vehicles. Directions are available on request.

By Air

- 35 min light aircraft flights between Victoria Falls Airport and Umtshibi Airfield or Hwange National Park. Seat rates are available. The Hide is just 40mins from Umtshibi Airfield or 1hr 30mins drive from Hwange Main Airport through the National Park. This transfer is conducted in a Hide open safari vehicle and offers game viewing opportunities.

ACCOMMODATION

The Hide has undergone 4 major renovations since it's inception in 1992, with the most recent being completed in 2014. The Hide sleeps up to 20 guests in 10 comfortable and spacious deluxe, family deluxe and honeymoon deluxe tents. The Tents have a myriad of different configurations with indoor and/or outdoor bathtubs and showers. Please request our Accommodation Facility Matrix for a clearer idea of the facilities in each tent.

2 Deluxe Tents can be used by families with children – Tents 6 & 7. The Hide has a No Under 10 year old age policy. We encourage families with younger children to book Tom's Little Hide or The Private Hide where children of any age are welcome.

Each tent has a private veranda from where guests may be entertained by the comings and goings of a large variety of game at the floodlit waterhole.

ACTIVITIES

Up to 4 activities/excursions are offered per day: morning and afternoon guided walks, morning and afternoon game drives; night drives with a spotlight, 'hide sits' around the pan. An overnight sleep-out in the "Dove's Nest" tree house for 2 people is a great experience.

FACTS & FACILITIES

- The hub of the camp is a majestic "A" frame which houses the dining room and sun lounge downstairs, private dining area and viewing area upstairs. Private dining or group dining is available on request.
- The swimming pool is uncovered with no fences – adults are responsible for their own children. The pools are not supervised!
- Early morning tea/coffee is delivered to your tent.
- Breakfast is served al fresco.
- Landline telephone service available at reception or a satellite phone is available for emergencies.
- Internet access using own WiFi device.
- Daily laundry service (weather permitting)
- Hair Dryers available on request.
- Check in is 12h00 and check out is 10h00
- Powered by mains electricity (220 volts). UK square plugs are used, please bring adapters.
- Some rooms are accessible for guests with disabilities.
- No children under 10 years unless in a group taking over the whole lodge or by prior arrangement.
